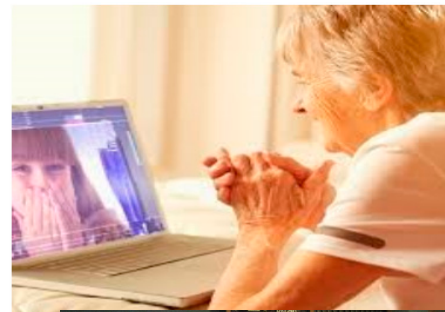
Never underestimate how special you are. We don't!
